

# Canaport LNG terminal



Canaport LNG is a state-of-the-art liquefied natural gas (LNG) receiving and regasification terminal — the first in Canada. Situated in Saint John, New Brunswick, the terminal is capable of sending 1.2 billion cubic feet of natural gas per day. It is majority-owned and managed by Repsol and is a partnership between Repsol of Spain (75%) and Irving Oil (25%). 28 million cubic metres of natural gas per day. Canaport LNG is able to supply 20% of the natural gas needs of the northeast US as well as Canadian needs.
